Judging of the Star Awards

Entries are solicited at the beginning of the year with a call for entries being distributed by the Minneapolis/St. Paul Chapter of the International Live Events Association. Entries are sought in 20+ various categories including event elements of catering, design and décor, graphic design, event logistics, technical production, sustainability factors, as well as corporate, social, non-profit, public and wedding event planning and photography. ILEA membership is not a requirement for entry.

Complete entries were reviewed by the Seattle, Michigan and Chicago chapters of ILEA for judging. The entries that received the highest total point score in a given category were named and the nominees and the entrant that received the top score was declared the winner. Each entry is required to meet the minimum score requirement and fulfill all of the entry criteria to be nominated, even when there are less than three applicants in the category. The names of the winners remain sealed and the awards company seals the statues in boxes until the day of the ceremony. The winner(s) become public record once the categories are presented at the ceremony.

All of the steps are in place to ensure the fairness and accuracy of the judging process, and maintain the highest standard of credibility for the Minnesota Star Awards.”
